COMMUNITY OPTIONS PROGRAM



Community Options Illawarra Inc. provides individual Case Management to meet the specific needs of frail older people and younger people with disabilities and their carers to assist them to continue living at home.

Eligibility

The program provides a flexible package of community care for home and community care (HACC) eligible clients who have complex care needs.

Who can Refer?

Anyone can refer to Community Options Illawarra Inc. by contacting one of our offices directly.

Following referral a Case Manager will contact you to determine eligibility, and discuss your needs.

The program provides:

- ◆ comprehensive assessment
- ◆ individual care planning
- ◆ information
- ◆ referral to services
- ◆ service coordination
- ◆ monitoring
- ◆ brokerage funds to provide services for assessed needs which are not available through mainstream services

Fees for service apply.
